When should you go?

Your first line of support when seeking health care

For non-life-threatening conditions when your doctor's office is unavailable

For life-threatening conditions and any type of medical emergency

Who will provide care?

Family doctor, internal medicine doctor, physician assistant or family nurse practitioner who helps manage your health, tracks your medical history, and provides personalized care

Doctor, nurse practitioner or nurse

Doctor, physician assistant, nurse practitioner or nurses who are specially trained in emergency medicine, trauma, and treating life-threatening conditions

How do you access care?

Appointments typically required

Walk-in service at HRRMC Buena Vista Health Center; first-come, first-served, appointments are not available. For more info, call 719-395-9048. Emergency care at the hospital in Salida; appointments are not available
