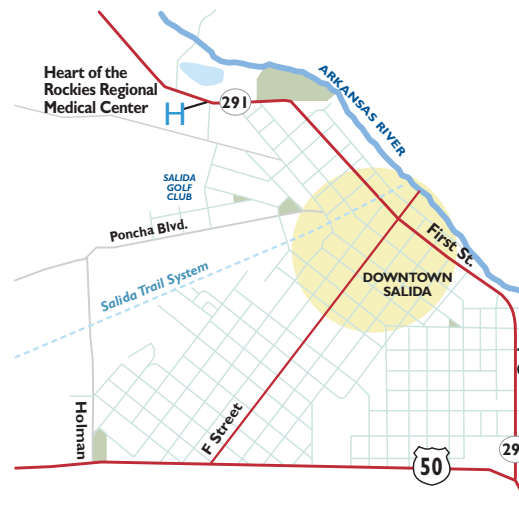

An oncology nurse navigator is a registered nurse with oncology-specific clinical knowledge. We are able to offer personalized assistance to patients, families and caregivers. Nurse navigators provide education to help you understand the specifics of the care you need so that you can make informed decisions.



We coordinate your treatments with the Infusion Department, help you make appointments with any other physicians you may need to see, schedule lab and imaging tests, teach you about your medications and treatments, and answer any questions you may have between doctor visits.
